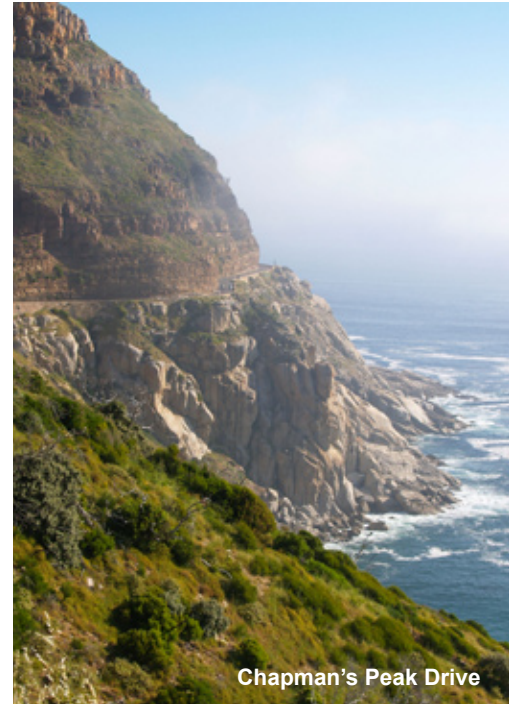

Sample Itinerary - SOUTH AFRICA:

Private transfers & tours • Special accommodations • Varied activities & experiences

Day 1: PORT ELIZABETH & ON SAFARI (D). Connect through Johannesburg to Port Elizabeth; meet our representative who drives you to your safari lodge (~1hr drive) for a 2-night stay. Afternoon safari activity is included today.

Consider a hot air balloon ride, seeing the Cango Caves, or a trip up Swartberg Pass.

Day 2: ON SAFARI (B, L, D). Get a taste of what "safari" is all about in open 4x4 vehicles with professional safari guides. Please see P. 2 for more on the safari experience.

Days 7 & 8: FRANSCHOEK (2B). Travel via Swellendam to Hermanus; watch for whales along the coast (June-Nov.). Continue to Franschhoek in the heart of wine country. Take Day 8 to explore, with your guide/driver, and savour the vineyards, estates and enjoy fine cuisine. Lunch suggestion: the Moyo restaurant in Stellenbosch's Spier Estate.

Days 3 & 4: GARDEN ROUTE/KNYSNA (2B). Morning safari activity then drive to the coast. Visit Tsitsikamma National Park. Options in Knysna include: walk part of the spectacular Otter Trail; boat trip on Plettenberg Bay in search of dolphins and other marine life, visit Featherbed Nature Reserve, go on a leisurely mountain bike ride or a forest walk. Options here and throughout depend on your interest and may involve a fee payable locally.

Day 9: CAPE TOWN (B). Relax or explore some more, then continue to Cape Town. Walk with your guide up Lions Head for views over the city.

Days 5 & 6: GARDEN ROUTE/OUTDSHOORN (2B, 2D). Day 5 is a travel day. Stops include Mossel Bay (to take the Outeniqua Choo Tjoe Steam Train to George). Drive over the pass to Oudtshoorn. Day 6 is a free day for you to fill as you choose to, with the help of your guide.

Days 10 & 11: CAPE TOWN (2B, 1D). Take a full day to drive around the Cape to Cape Point with your guide; stop at Boulders Beach to see the penguins. Option: Martha Williams Cooking Experience for dinner. Day 11 includes a boat trip to Robben Island, the amazing Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens; and the cable car ride up Table Mountain - spectacular at sunset. Farewell Dinner is included tonight.

Day 12: DEPART (B). Transfer to the airport.

About the Safari experience in South Africa:

In the time frame of our sample itinerary, we can only include an introductory safari experience to areas that are easy to get to and that provide a good, solid, gameviewing experience. To see and experience more, you would start by adding more days to the safari portion of your trip.

Our 5 paw sample uses Shamwari Private Game Reserve (see the Big 5 and other species). Our 3 & 4 paw sample visits Amakhala Game Reserve, Addo Elephant National Park (some

of finest elephant viewing in the world plus the rest of the Big 5, and spotted hyena, greater kudu, eland, red hartebeest and bushbuck) and includes a river cruise.

If budget allows, you may wish to consider other safari destinations that may require charter flights to reach, such as Phinda Private Game Reserve in east South Africa (5 paw), or the private concessions that fringe Kruger National Park, such as Pafuri Camp in the Makuleke private concession (4 paw).
